Assessment and Recognition:

- To be eligible for the award of the certificate, participants must PASS the test with 80 marks or above (total: 100 mark). A student obtaining a score of less than 80% is failed.
- If a student obtains a score with 90 marks or above, a wording "Pass with Distinction" will be marked on the certificate
- Only person who passed the Dangerous goods Regulations training course within the past 24 months can sign the "Shipper's Declaration for Dangerous Goods".

Admission Requirements:

 Applicants must be a certificate holder of recognized "Initial Dangerous Goods Regulations Training" or "Recurrent Dangerous Goods Regulations Training" course which is not yet expired. (Proof of certificate is required.)
